ABSTRACT OF EVIDENCE.

In the case of

C.P.O. (Hawaii) KAGAMI

Civilian attd Navy KUBOKI Noboru.

C.P.O. KAGAMI was the officer commanding assistant field overseer KUBOKI, at OGRABRIJ, PORT BLAIR. KUBOKI states he had orders from KAGAMI that he could beat those who did not work properly.

Evidence will be given by witnesses that in the months of June, July and August 1945 KUBOKI did in fact beat and kill four civilians. The statement of KUBOKI will be produced in evidence.
