1. Dr. Radovan Karadzic hereby discloses expert reports of Mile Poparic and provides notice, pursuant to Rule 94 *bis*, that he intends to call Mile Poparic as an expert witness in his defence case.

2. Mile Poparic is a weapons and military equipment expert. He has a Bachelor's Degree in Military Mechanical Engineering and is the author of numerous articles on issues of his expertise.



Mile Poparic was requested by the defence to study sniping incidents scheduled in the Indictment regarding Sarajevo, reports and testimonies of prosecution military experts Berko Zecevic and Richard Higgs, as well as testimonies and documents tendered through other prosecution witnesses, and to refute those aspects of reports, testimonies and documents which he believes to be incorrect. Mile Poparic has done so, and has produced two separate reports.

4. Mile Poparic will present the findings of his reports as a *viva voce* witness.
