

PROSECUTOR'S RESPONSE TO

"Request for Leave to Appear as Amicus Curiae pursuant to Rule 74 of the ICTR Rules of Procedure and Evidence", filed by Human Rights Watch on 25 October 2007

RESPONSE

- 1. On 25 October 2007, Human Rights Watch filed its Request for Leave to Appear as Amicus Curiae pursuant to Rule 74 of the ICTR Rules of Procedure and Evidence (hereinafter, "the Application").
- 2. The Prosecutor does not oppose the Application of Human Rights Watch to file an *amicus curiae* brief.
- 3. However, the Prosecutor requests the Trial Chamber that, if the Trial Chamber were to grant the Application, Human Rights Watch be required to file its *amicus curiae* brief within seven days (7) of the issuance of the decision, to avoid undue delay to the Rule 11 *bis* process, for the following reasons:
 - a) The *Prosecutor's Rule 11bis Request* was filed publicly on 11 June 2007. The Application was filed on 25 October 2007. Human Rights Watch should, if it wanted, have filed its Application as soon as the document was filed.
 - b) It appears from the Application that Human Rights Watch has already taken a position with respect to the issues it wishes to address the Trial Chamber on, such as the accused's fair trial rights. It also appears from the Application that Human Rights Watch has the information to support its claims. Therefore, the time-limit of seven days seems to be reasonable in the current circumstances.
 - c) In view of the importance of Rule 11 bis transfers in light of the completion strategy of this Tribunal, and the scheduling of cases either for trial or transfer, an expeditious determination of the *Prosecutor's Rule 11 bis Request* is warranted. Human Rights Watch should, therefore, be required to file its amicus curiae brief within the time frame requested above to avert any further delays.

- 4. In addition, the Prosecutor requests the Trial Chamber, if it were to grant the Application, to be allowed to file submissions in response to the merits of the submissions contained in the *amicus curiae* brief to be filed by Human Rights Watch.
