Indeed this negotiations was what was settled by sincerity.

Neither wisdom, courage, faith nor courtesy, but pure and unalloyed and gem-like sincerity could only lead that crisis to a settlement in a conversation and smiles. In other words, Nanghu, without a bit of secret, Kaishu, with a broad vision on the general situation, became exactly accorded with each other.

Thus both SAIGO and KATSU suspended hostilities at the moment when the time was most ripe for a war. It seems to me that there are found the spirit of our Imperial Army and the first principle of founding our Army.
