Vienna Accused: Izzat Ibrahim Khalil Al Doori, currently in
Doebling private clinic

Accusation: § 87. Abs.1 & 2 StGB

The Public Prosecutor Vienna is advised of the following
situation:

Izzat Ibrahim Khalil Al Doori is currently undergoing medical
treatment in Austria. He fulfilled in the last many years
various responsible functions within the Iraqi Government.
Currently he holds as Deputy Chairman of the Revolutionary
Counsel, the second highest political function in Iraq.

In 1972, as President of a Special Court he murdered with his
own hands one of the opposition members. He shares the
responsibility for the poison gas attack on Halabje in March
1988 and for the destruction of the Kurdish uprising,
following the Gulf War.

For these acts, as well as numerous other crimes against
humanity, it is not legally possible to prosecute him in
Austria.

The Accused, however carries the responsibility for the arrest
and torture of Mr. Faeq Rasul and Mr. Sal am Abdullah Ibrahim,
as well as numerous other victims. These acts should be
classified as torture under the Agreement against torture and
other gruesome, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment
(BGBl. 1987/492). Under Article 5 of this Agreement, the
signatory countries of the Agreement accept the right to legal
action for acts that can be classified as torture,
irrespective of where such acts were committed. Austria,
following its responsibilities under §64, Abs 1. Zif 6. StGB
has fulfilled this responsibility. According to Article 6 of
this Agreement, Austria has under international and its
national law the responsibility to arrest the Accused and to
take all other steps to ensure his presence. Furthermore
Austria must immediately initiate preliminary investigations
to ascertain the
facts of the case against the Accused.

Mr. Faeq Rasul was arrested in his house in Karkuk in 1981
under an arrest action involving 60 persons. He was initially
taken to the Haiae Al Khasse prison and after passed to the
Security Directorate in Karkuk. He was kept there for 5 months
and tortured in an inhuman way. Mr. Rasul suffers to this day

as a result of these misdeeds.

Mr, Izzat Ibrahim Khalil Al Doori, as one of the most important political officials, carried the responsibility for the Kurdish Regions.

After 5 months the prisoners were transferred to Baghdad and many sentenced to death.

Mr. Rasul was given a 7 year prison sentence.

Following negotiations between PUK and the Iraqi government, an amnesty was declared in 1983 and Mc Rasul was released. He is currently in Austria.

Similarly the accused carried responsibility for the arrest and torture of Mr. Salam Abdullah Ibrahim. He was arrested in October 1980 and in the Abu Greb prison in Baghdad for the following 2 years was exposed to torture and ill-treatments through the orders of the Accused.

In addition the undersigned is able to submit numerous other examples of torture, including one case in which the accused personally carried out the tortures.

The Public Prosecutor Vienna is requested [0 arrange the arrest of the Accused Izzat Ibrahim Khalil Al Doori and to commence with the investigation of the facts of the case.
