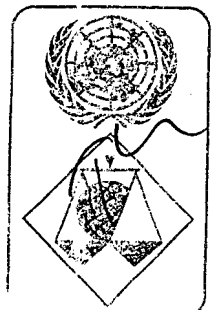

**PROSECUTION'S NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE WITH DECISION ON
DEFENCE REQUEST FOR ACCESS TO CONFIDENTIAL MATERIALS FROM
THE *KARADŽIĆ* CASE
(CORRIGENDUM)**

1. The Prosecution updates its notice of compliance¹ ("the Notice") with the Decision on Defence Request for Access to Confidential Materials from the *Karadžić* Case.² This corrigendum corrects and replaces the Notice filed on 5 February 2013.
2. The Prosecution indicates to the Registry that the Accused Mladić should be given immediate access to all confidential *inter partes* material listed in the corrected and updated **Confidential Annex A**.
3. **Confidential and *ex parte* Annex B** identifies the corrected and updated confidential exhibits subject to Rule 70 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence that should not be provided to the Accused Mladić at this point in time. In accordance with the Access Decision, the Prosecution will seek the requisite consent from the relevant providers for disclosure to the Accused Mladić. When the Rule 70 condition is lifted, the

Prosecution will notify the Trial Chamber, the Registry and the Accused Mladić accordingly. If consent is refused, the Prosecution will notify the Chamber.

4. In accordance with the Decision, the Prosecution will continue to identify material for disclosure to the Accused Mladić and will notify the Chamber and the Registry accordingly.
