REQUEST OF THE ACCUSED HATA, SHUNROKU, FOR THE PRODUCTION OF A WITNESS PURSUANT TO SECTION III, ARTICLE 9, SUBSECTION "e" OF THE CHARTER OF THE INTERNATIONAL MILITARY TRIBUNAL FOR THE FAR EAST, DATED 26 APRIL, 1946.

COMES NOW, HATA, Shunroku, by Masayoshi Kanzaki and 1st Lt. Aristides G. Lazarus, U.S. Marine Corps, Counsel for the accused HATA, Shunroku, and requests this Tribunal to enter the proper order for the production of Hikosaburo Hata as a witness before this Tribunal and in support thereof presents to the court the following information:

- 1. Hikosaburo Hata, then a Lieutenant General in the Japanese Army, was Chief of Staff of the Kwantung Army when Russia entered the war.
 - 2. Mothing further is known of him since that time.
- 3. The appearance of the witness Mikosaburo Hata is necessary to prove that the Hata mentioned in many of the counts of the indictment is in fact Wikosaburo Hata, the Lieutenant General and not Shunroku Hata, the Field Marshall, who is the accused now before this Tribunal.
- 4. Through the witness Wikosaburo Hata, the accused Shunroku Hata will prove conclusively the facts of mistaken identity.
