

Further to the Decision of Pre-Trial Chamber II "*Decision to terminate the proceedings against Raska Lukwiya*" issued on 11 July 2007; I would like to notify you, as the person designated under Article 87(1) (a) of the Rome Statute, that the proceedings against Raska Lukwiya have been terminated.


The Chamber has decided, on the basis of the death certificate transmitted by the Republic of Uganda on 19 June 2007 certifying that Raska Lukwiya died on 12 August 2006 in Mucwini, Kitgum District, and given the fact that the Court has no jurisdiction over a person who has deceased, that all proceedings be terminated against that person and that all relevant documents be rendered without effect.

Furthermore, please note that, pursuant to Regulation 42 of the Regulations of the Court, all the protective measures that have been ordered to the benefit of victims and witnesses are still in effect.


