- I, VAGN JOENSEN, Judge of the International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals ("Mechanism") am seised of an application for leave to reply filed by Jean de Dieu Kamuhanda ("Kamuhanda") in relation to the Prosecution's response to Kamuhanda's request that an amicus curiae Prosecutor be appointed to complete the investigation into allegations of false testimony against Prosecution Witness GEK during Kamuhanda's trial before the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda.¹
