CHARGES

1st Charge COMMITTING A WAR CRIME in that they at OHLENDORF nr BRUNSWICK Germany, btwn May 1943 and March 1945 when officials responsible for working conditions in the Worthlah Iron Ore Mine, in violation of the laws and usages of war, employed British prisoners of war on unhealthy and dangerous work, thereby causing the death of No. 3314132 Pte Andrew THOMPSON YOUNG of the Cameron Highlanders and injuries to other British prisoners of war.

Charge against KOLLER only

COMMITTING A WAR CRIME in that he at OHLENDORF nr BRUNSWICK, Germany, on a day in June 1944 in violation of the laws and usages of war, assaulted Cpl BROWN, a British prisoner of war.

Charge against ZIEGLER only

COMMITTING A WAR CRIME in that he at OHLENDORF nr BRUNSWICK, Germany, on a day in January 1944 in violation of the laws and usages of war, assaulted No. 2327930 Sgmn G.W. GROCIETT and other British and Allied prisoners of war.
