DECISION

THE PRINCIPAL DEFENDER,

CONSIDERING the Statute of the Special Court for Sierra Leone and in particular Article 17 thereof;

CONSIDERING the Rules of Procedure and Evidence as adopted by the Plenary meeting of the Special Court for Sierra Leone on 7 March 2003, and modified on 1 August 2003 and 30 October 2003, and in particular Rules 45 thereof;

CONSIDERING the Directive on the Assignment of Counsel as adopted by the Registrar on 1 October 2003, and in particular Article 10 thereof;

CONSIDERING the request of Mr. Morris Kallon for the appointment of counsel, on 12 March 2003;

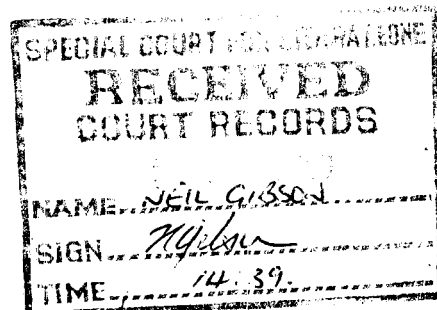
CONSIDERING that the Principal Defender may, in the interests of justice, assign counsel to represent the accused;

CONSIDERING that Mr. James Oury of the United Kingdom meets the requirements for the assignment of counsel to an indigent accused;

CONSIDERING that the accused may not have sufficient means at the present time to retain counsel on his own;

CONSIDERING that Mr. James Oury has agreed to represent the accused under the terms of a Legal Services Contract with the Defence Office of the Special Court for Sierra Leone for the provision of legal services to the accused; and


CONSIDERING that Mr. James Oury has stated that he is available to represent the accused to the finality of the case at trial, as stated in the Statement of Availability attached herewith.

DIRECTS the assignment of Mr. James Oury as Assigned Counsel to the accused, effective from the date of his Provisional Assignment of 01 May 2003, under the terms of the Legal Services Contract with the Defence Office of the Special Court for Sierra Leone for the provision of legal services to the accused, for the duration of the trial, except in so far as a decision under article 23 or 24 of the Directive on the Assignment of Counsel may direct.

Appointed by Mr. Morris Kallon, for the purposes of proceedings before the Special Court for Sierra Leone,


Hereby undertake, pursuant to Rules 45 (C) and (E) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence:
