Scheduling Order 1 October 2008

1. Under Rules 54 and 90 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Chamber issues this scheduling order, which details the order of presentation and time allotted for Édouard Karemera's witnesses for the eighth trial session. The order of presentation of the witnesses, and the individual time allocated for each witness, is based on Karemera's filing of 11 July 2008, titled: "Soumission aux fins de communication de l'ordre de passage des témoins à décharge de Édouard Karemera". The total days for the presentation of Karemera's witnesses during the eighth trial session is based on the Chamber's Order of 16 July 2008.

- 2. The scheduling order also takes into account two witnesses from the seventh trial session whose testimony was carried over to the eighth trial session (XQU, cross-examination only, and WKL).
- 3. The order of presentation of Édouard Karemera's 34 remaining witnesses is as follows: XQU (cross-examination and re-direct examination only), ETB, UOW, ECM, XCU, RTM, ETK, WDU, DPL, RON, XWZ, BW; Ndayisba, Abraham; XOV, WTE, XLL, EPJ, XLW, DEU, UMP, XPV, NKM, LHK, CO, UKJ, BOJ, QTC, DSV, KBX, TZL, XXW, XKK, and Karemera himself. The Chamber urges Karemera to always have one witness available to fill in any unexpected gaps that may arise due to witness unavailability.
- 4. The Chamber also notes that of one of Joseph Nzirorera's witnesses, Léon Mugesera, will testify during the eighth trial session via video-link from Quebec City. Mugesera's testimony is scheduled at 15:00 hours, Arusha time, on 10 November 2008.
- 5. A scheduling grid for all witnesses to be called during the eighth trial session is being prepared by the Chamber, and will be distributed to the parties shortly.

FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER

- **I. ORDERS** the parties to abide by this scheduling order; and
- **II. REQUESTS** the Registry to facilitate the video-link testimony of Witness Léon Mugesera from Quebec City at 8 hours, local time (15:00 hours, Arusha time), on 10 November 2008.
