SWORE DEPOSITION

Deponent: YAMAZAKI, Iwae

Having first duly swern an oath as on attached shoot and in accordance with the procedure followed in my country I hereby depose as follows.

- 1. I, YAMAZAFI, Iwao held various offices in the Ministry of Home Affairs from 1919 to 1939. From January, 1939 to July, 1939. I served as Chief of the Pelice Affairs Burers in the Home Ministry. From December, 1939 to October, 1940. I served as Chief of Metropolitan Police. From October, 1940 to August, 1945 I held various positions such as Vice Minister of Home Affairs and in the Civil Administration of Occupied Torritories. In August, 1945, I was appointed Minister of Home Affairs, but resigned as Home Minister in October the same year.
- 2. As Chief of the Police Affairs Bureau in the Home
 Ministry, it was my responsibility to preserve law and order

throughout Japan and it was part of any duties to try and prevent anticipated incidents "rem arising and in the event that they did occour to take no cossary steps to subdue them. In order to accomplish this effectively, it was necessary that I keepmmyself well informed warious movements among the civilian populations and to ascertain the opinions and purposos of various group I constantly recieved reported from my subordinates in connection with these matters. While I was serving as Chief of the Police Affairs Bureau in the Home Ministry, the schoolled July 5th incident cocurred in July, 1940. From reports I recioved I as-cortained that the July 5th incident was plotted by more than 30 members of a rightist reformist group, led by MAYEDA, Torac and KAGEYAMA, Masaharu in attempts to assassinate those whome they regarded as pro-Amorican and pro-British advocates of the status que or liberalists. This group believed these proported victims were obstructing it projected national reform. The plot was timed for before daybroak, July 5, 1940, but due to advance information we had recieved, the assassinations were prevented and all of the plotters were rounded up just when they were leaving their base of operation, fully armed with hand grenades, revolvers, Japanese swords, and various other weapons. At this time Marquis KIDO was the Lord Keeper of the

Privy Seal. The Metalopalitan Police interegated these would be assassins and found out that the target of their attempted assassinations included the following:

- (1) Prime Minister YONAI, as representative of the Government.
- (2) Mr. YUASA, Kurahoi formor Lord Koeper of the Privy Seal;
 Admiral OKADA, ex-Premier; Baron HARADA, Kumac; Count
 MAKINO, formor Lord Koeper of the Privy Seal; Marquis
 KIDO, Lord Koeper of the Privy Seal and Mr. MATSUDAIRA,
 Tsunec, Minister the Imporial Household, and the seal and Mr. Matsudaire.

as representatives of the South Statesmen.

- (3) Mr. IKEDA, Soihin and two others as representatives of private industries.
- others as representatives of the political parties.

 Complete reports of the interegations of the plotters were submitted to me which verified the above. The would be assassins were duly tried, convicted and sentenced to prison terms. Additional police protection for the abovementioned proposed victions was provided for a period of time.
- I was in charge of an investigation regarding a shooting affair which occurred against Baron HIR NUMA in August, 1941.

 It was perpetrated by a cortain NISHIYAMA, Tadashi, a provincial

member of the Makoto Musubi, one of the pro-German reformist groups, which advocated the urgent necessity for Japan to go to war promptly with America and Britain and to offect as shuthern advance as a sequel to the opening of hestilities between Germany and the Sevier Union in June, the same year. The would be assassins marked Baron HIR NUMA cut as Senior Statesman opposed to war with Amorica and Britain. He called on the Baron at his residence and fired upon the latter, who, however, fortunately, caped with a slight injury. NISHIY:MA was approhonded tried, convicted and sentenced to penal servitude: Inasmuchhas Prime Minister KCNOYE was generally regarded as endeavoring hard to avoid war with America, an emineus atmosphero provailed in the pro-German refermist groups in this country. Roports I recieved in my official capacity completely substantiated this. Marquis KIDO, then Lord for of the Privy Soal as well as Prince KONOYE, Prime Minister : a in danger of falling a victim to the rightist reformist groups' torreristic action as pre-American and pre-British Senior Statesmen close to the Throne. Accordingly, as procautionary measure, the police authorities protected the Marquis from personal danger for a prolonged period of time from the time of the shorting affair against Baron HIRANUMA to after the opening of hestilitie between Japan and America, by increasing
